THE INVISIBLE DANGER: "FOG"



DO'S

Reduce Speed and Increase Following Distance



Drive at a speed where you can stop within the distance you can see and double the following distance.

Use Correct Lights: Low Beams and Fog Lights



Turn on your low beams. If visibility drops significantly, turn on front and rear fog lights.

Focus on the Road and Follow Road Lines



Turn off the radio, listen for sounds, and use road lines as reference.

DON'TS

Never Use High Beams



High beams reflect off the fog, creating a "wall of light" that worsens visibility.

Do Not Use Hazard Lights continuously While Driving



Hazard lights are for sudden dangers or obstacles only, not as a continuous driving signal.

Avoid Sudden Maneuvers and Tailgating



Using the vehicle in front as a guide and unnecessary overtaking is very dangerous.
