If you cannot see the driver or their mirrors, the driver definitely cannot see you! Always try to make eye contact with the driver before crossing the street.

Never get too close to trucks; always keep a distance of at least 5-6 big steps. When you are too close, the vehicle is so high that it becomes impossible for the driver to notice you.

The sides of large vehicles become very dangerous blind spots when they are turning. Avoid standing right next to a truck's left or right side, as the driver might not see you during a turn.

Never walk directly in front of or behind a truck. These vehicles are so tall that the driver cannot see a small child right under the "nose" or directly behind the trailer.
