NATIONWIDE TRAFFIC COLLISIONS



TOTAL INCIDENTS

In October 2025, 58,783 traffic collisions occurred nationwide (180 fatal, 24,620 with injury, and 33,983 with property damage).

CASUALTIES


Nationwide in October, 201 citizens lost their lives, and 34,173 people were injured (due to traffic collisions).

LOCATION

In October 2025, while the highest number of collisions in Turkey occurred in Ankara (property damage), the province with the highest number of fatalities was Istanbul, with 11 deaths.

ENFORCEMENT

A total of 2,975,293 penal sanctions were applied nationwide in October.



Includes the number of fatalities occurring at the accident scene.

Property-damage-only accidents where the parties filed a mutual report among themselves are not included.



DRIVER FACTOR

Drivers rank first among the actors causing collisions in October. They are followed by Pedestrians with a rate of 8%.



APPARENT CAUSE

Among Driver Faults in fatal/injury traffic collisions, the largest share belongs to "Failure to adjust vehicle speed to road and weather conditions."



COLLISION TYPE

"When fatal/injury traffic collisions occurring in October are evaluated by collision type, 'Side Impact' accounts for the largest share."
