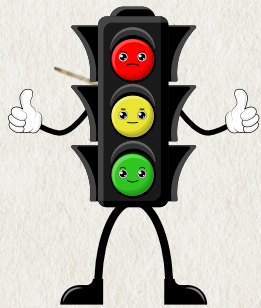

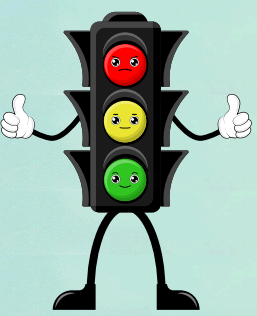

## SAFE AREAS



### PARKS

Large parks and fenced areas prevent the ball from escaping. There is no traffic.



### GARDENS

Gardens of houses or residential complexes (private property) have safe boundaries. Avoid damaging plants. Get permission from the residents.



### SPORTS FIELDS

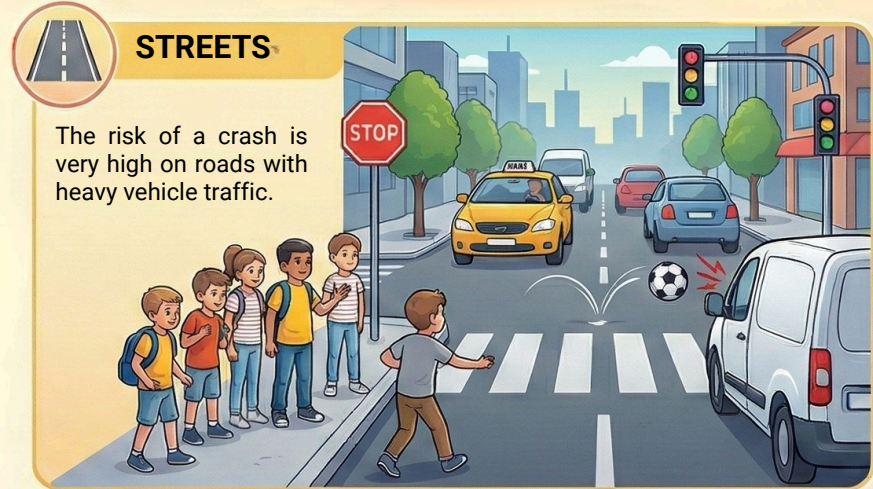
Football fields and municipal playgrounds are places without traffic flow. There are boundaries to prevent the ball from escaping.



### SCHOOL YARDS

These are enclosed areas without traffic flow. Use them with permission from the school administration (outside of school hours).

## UNSAFE AREAS



### STREETS

The risk of a crash is very high on roads with heavy vehicle traffic.



### SIDE STREETS

Side streets and narrow roads are not suitable for playing ball. Visibility is limited. Unexpected vehicles may appear on the road.
