NATIONWIDE TRAFFIC COLLISIONS



TOTAL INCIDENTS

In July 2026, a total of 64,255 road traffic crashes occurred nationwide, including 191 fatal crashes, 29,993 injury crashes, and 34,071 property-damage-only crashes.

CASUALTIES

In July, 225 people lost their lives and 43,361 people were injured in road traffic crashes nationwide.

LOCATION

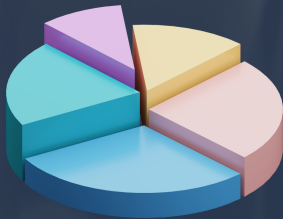
In July 2026, Ankara recorded the highest number of property-damage-only road traffic crashes in Türkiye, while Antalya had the highest number of road traffic fatalities by province, with 17 deaths.

LEGAL ACTION

In July, a total of 2,416,380 traffic penalties were issued nationwide.



Includes the number of fatalities occurring at the accident scene.



Property-damage-only accidents where the parties filed a mutual report among themselves are not included.



DRIVER FACTOR

In July, drivers were the leading road users responsible for traffic crashes, followed by pedestrians at 6.4%.

APPARENT CAUSE

Among driver-related factors in fatal and injury road traffic crashes, the most common was failing to adjust vehicle speed to road and weather conditions.

COLLISION TYPE

When fatal and injury road traffic crashes in July were evaluated by collision type, side-impact collisions accounted for the largest share. Rollover crashes accounted for 16.9%.
